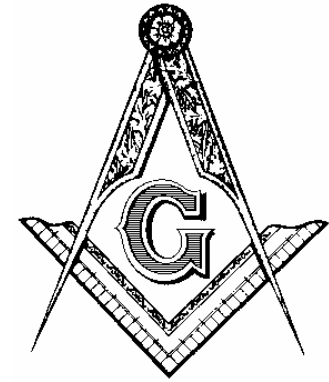


## Jobs Daughters

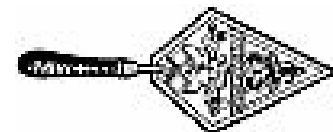
